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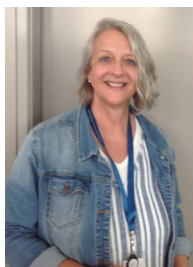
Dear parents and carers,

Below, is a small blurb that allows you some insight into their work. Of course, we could not forget Meesha, the therapy dog who is also here for students on most days. It seems that she is quite the highlight for our all children, including the older students.



Leonie Harbeck is a social worker, she also has a Bachelor of Psychology degree. She has worked in early years, primary and secondary education in education support, as a facilitator of supported playgroups, parenting groups and access to the early learning programs and social worker. She also has experience as a child and family therapist which adds to her extensive lived experience as mother, grandmother and farmer in remote and regional parts of Victoria. Leonie has also done long-term community volunteer work. She travels to Corryong weekly from Murchison near Shepparton in central Victoria.

Kerrie Staun has been involved in education for most of her life. Teaching for 20 + years then moving into student support services (SSS) role after gaining a social work degree and becoming an accredited mental health social worker and a family therapist. She has worked in this role for the last 15 years, managing and responding to critical incidents in schools to support parents, staff and children. She was involved in supporting schools for an extended period in Morwell after 2009 bush fires. Her interest and work has always been in assisting children, adolescents and their families with prevention and management tools for anxiety, depression & trauma. Kerrie's interest has also led her to training in Critical Incident management with CIMA International and Psychological first aide training with Rob Gordon. Kerrie has a trained therapy dog that she uses to assist schools parents and children every day and when there have been major distresses or events.

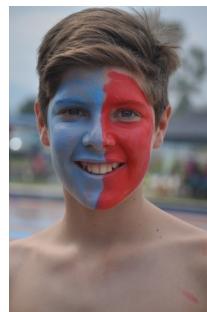

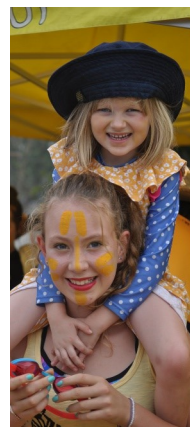
