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Dear parents and carers,

I trust that all of our mothers, and mother figures in our children's lives, had a beautiful day on Mothers Day. We thank you all for everything you bring to our children's lives and to the community.

We have made it. In the hurdles that have been in the last months, I congratulate all of you on your great work and support for our college community and more importantly, for our students, as we moved through the vast learning curve of remote learning.

As I mentioned in the letter home this week, the dedication from our staff has gone above and beyond anything that was expected. All of us have been thrown in the deep end; parents, carers, families, students and staff. However, in our return to school it is important that we remain vigilant in our hygiene and social distancing where possible. On a health level, we are not out of the woods yet. We need to work together to ensure risk minimisation, the staged return and following actions that are currently being refined. For now, the following schedule is confirmed.

Wednesday 20th May - Pupil Free Day - No remote learning for students/staff (moved from original date of 3rd June to better suit families). Staff report writing and planning for return to school.

Monday 25th May - Pupil Free Day - No remote learning for students/staff. All staff will return to onsite. Staff report writing and planning for return to school.

Tuesday 26th May - Foundation to Year 2 and Year 11-12 students return to **on-site classes**. Year 11-12 Coordinators will be sending out a letter to Year 11/12 students and parents with details around staged return. This will also include information for Year 10 students completing a VCE subject.

Tuesday 9th June - Year 3 to Year 10 students return to **on-site classes** as per normal timetable.

Further information regarding restrictions around access to school for parents/carers/visitors and risk minimisation procedures will be put out through letters home via Xuno/email next week. **However, if your child requires uniforms, please order and pay over the phone during the week of 18th and 22nd May. When the order is available, you will be called and a time negotiated for collection outside the office. Puffer Jacket/Vest orders due 29th May.**

Thank you to Year 11/12 Coordinators Sarah Klippel and Sandra Kovacic, and all the Year 11/12 teachers who have really served our students well in this stressful time.

All Foundation to Grade 4 students have been busy with their home learning. Students are engaged daily with a variety of activities offered both on and offline.

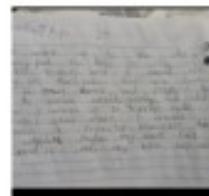
Each student has access to either Google Classroom or ClassDojo where they can celebrate their learning and receive feedback from their teachers.

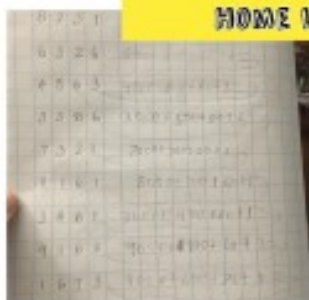

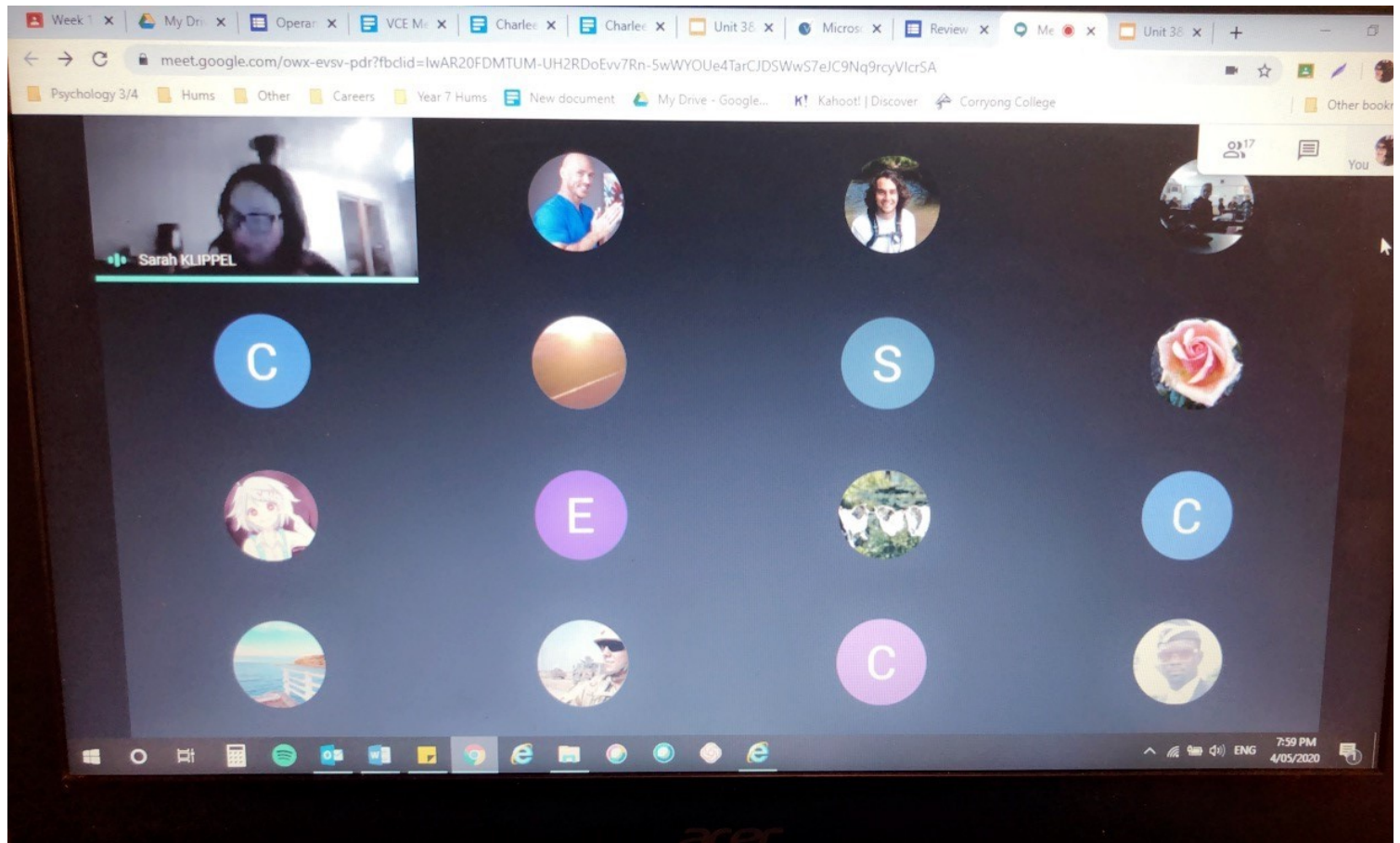
Year 12 Information evening – A huge success
